

Extraction Techniques

- Accelerated Solvent Extraction (ASE)
- Solid Phase Extraction (SPE)
- Solid Phase Microextraction (SPME)
- Hollow Fiber - Liquid Phase Microextraction (HF-LPME)
- Liquid-Liquid Extraction (LLE)
- Ultrasonic Extraction (USE)

Derivatisation Methods

- Silylation (BSTFA, MTBSTFA)
- Methylation (TMSDAM, CH₂N₂)
- Thiolation (Butanethiol, Dimercaptotoluene)
- Specific Derivatisations (Alcohols)

Gas Chromatography (GC)

Liquid Chromatography (LC)

- LC-DAD (Diode Array Detector)
- LC-SPE (LC Coupling with Solid Phase Extraction)

Mass Spectrometry (MS)

- GC-MS (EI, Methane-Cl and Isobutane-Cl)
- LC-MS/MS (ESI and APCI)



High Resolution Mass Spectrometry (HR-MS)

- LC-UHR-QTOF (ESI, APCI, APCI Direct Probe)
- GC-HR-QTOF (EI, Methane-Cl)

Nuclear Magnetic Resonance Spectroscopy (NMR)

- 600 MHz NMR with different CryoProbes:
 - CPQCI for ¹H-³¹P, ¹³C, ¹⁵N, and Deuterium (lock)
 - CPBBO for ¹H, ¹⁹F, and NMR nuclei from ³¹P to ¹⁵N
