Workshop on CWC obligations - SECO and Spiez Laboratory

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen

The <u>National Authority CWC</u> (Chemical Weapons Convention) is organising a one-day course for the chemical industry and trading companies on CWC obligations. Participants will be instructed on how to complete and submit the annual <u>OPCW</u> (Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons) declarations to the Spiez Laboratory. Furthermore, the training will provide an overview of the CWC, national legislation and inspections by the OPCW.

As a State Party to the CWC, Switzerland is contractually obliged to report all relevant CWC activities to the OPCW <u>Technical Secretariat</u> in The Hague. The Spiez Laboratory is entrusted with this task, i.e., it requests the declarations from the companies, compiles them and then forwards them to the OPCW before the deadline.

There are two training dates that you can choose from, either on **Tuesday, 02 September 2025** or on **Thursday, 04 September 2025**, at <u>Spiez Laboratory</u>. Registrations will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis. If there is a great deal of interest, we will decide at short notice whether to split the event or hold a further information session.

This course, co-organised by the State Secretariat for Economic Affairs (SECO) and the Spiez Laboratory, is usually offered every three years. Therefore, we encourage you not to miss it. Your company will be able to fill in the required forms in a more targeted and quicker fashion. In addition, you will get to know representatives of the National Authority CWC personally, which is particularly helpful in the case of OPCW inspections or clarification of questions. Please note that due to specific obligations, trading companies can choose to leave the course earlier if they wish (see programme).

The event is free of charge and will be held **in English** on **02 September** and **in German** on **04 September**. Travel to and from the event and, if necessary, accommodation is to be arranged by the participants themselves. Free parking is available at the Spiez Laboratory. The canteen offers a rich lunch (16.- / person).


